

BEHAVIOUR POLICY ON RESIDENTIAL

All pupils who go on a residential must follow this policy. This must be signed and dated by parents/guardians.

The Behaviour Policy is based upon the "Traffic Light Code"

Rules of the Traffic Light Code:-

- * **GREEN** All children begin in the green light sector. This behaviour at this point poses no cause for concern.

- * **AMBER** Parents / Guardians will be informed as soon as possible if their child's behaviour is such that they are placed in the amber zone.
 - Name Calling
 - Back Chat
 - Quarrelling
 - Entering others' rooms
 - Interfering with others' possessions
 - Failure to carry out centre duties.

- * **RED** Immediately, or at the earliest opportunity parents / guardians will be informed to take their child (ren) home.
 - Fighting
 - Bad Language
 - Bullying
 - Causing others to be in danger or at risk
 - Damaging others' property
 - Damaging centre property.

This code is to ensure the Health, Safety and Enjoyment of all pupils on the trip. By simply displaying good manners and polite behaviour, there should be no requirement for any sanctions to be imposed.

Pupils are advised not to bring mobile phones or personalised stereos. These are expensive items and we do not want them lost, stolen or damaged. The children can phone home, as Y.M.C.A. is equipped with pay phones.
